This is based on the values of community, honesty, innovation, integrity, responsibility, responsiveness, trust, leadership and accountability.

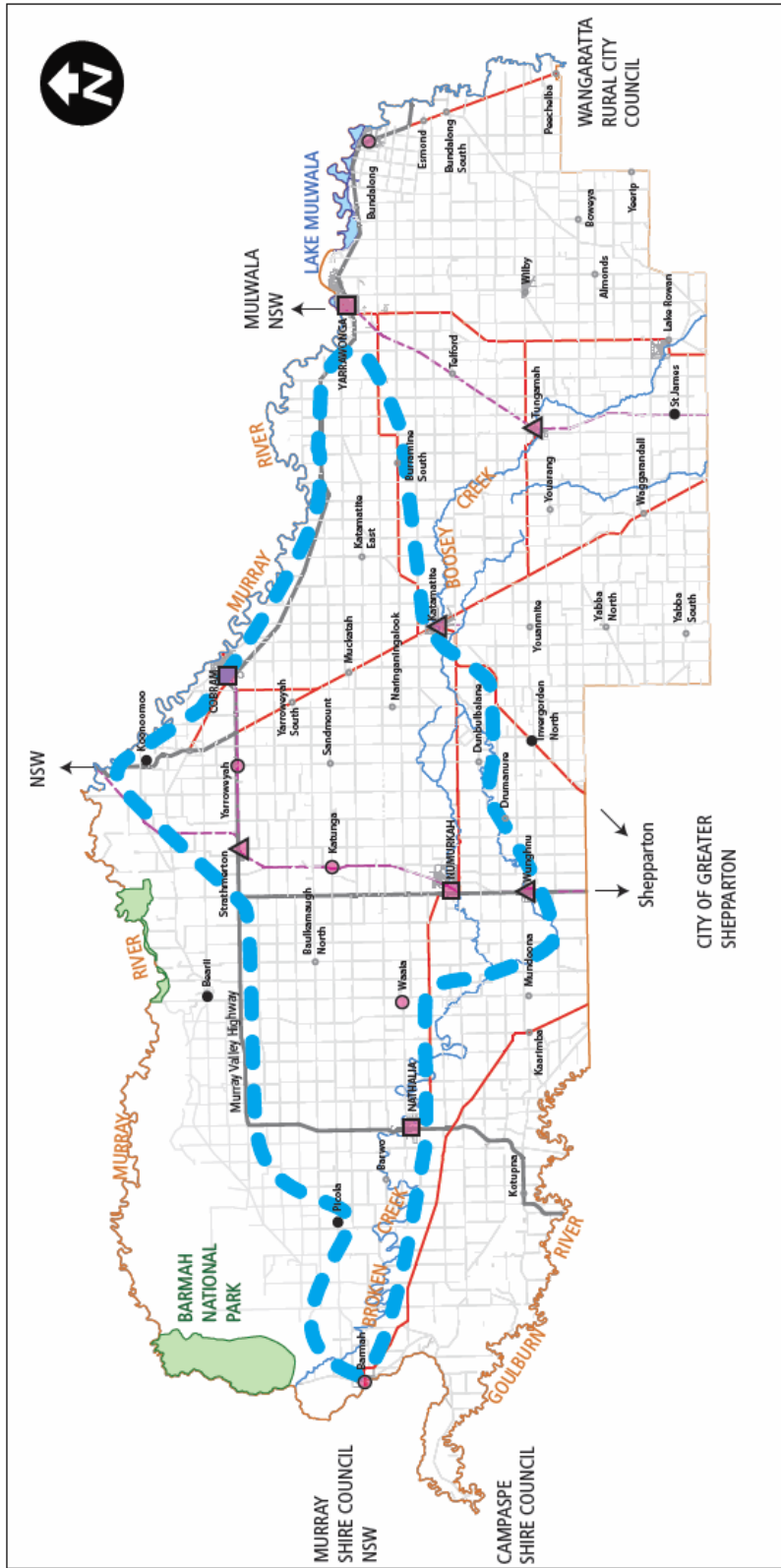
21.02-3 Municipal Strategic Framework Plan

Moira Shire is located in the Hume region of Victoria and stretches from Bundalong in the east to the Barmah National Park to the west. The northern boundary is defined by the Murray River and south-west, southern and south east regions share boundaries with Councils of Campaspe, Greater Shepparton, Benalla, Wangaratta and Indigo. Moira is centrally located to the regional cities of Shepparton, Wangaratta and Albury-Wodonga.
