A review of this planning scheme must be undertaken at least once every three years. The Local Planning Policy Framework, comprising this PSS provides the strategic foundation for the Port of Melbourne Planning Scheme. Due to the dynamic nature of port planning issues, the PSS will be regularly reviewed on an ongoing basis to ensure that it is relevant and reflects current issues.

The monitoring program will focus on key elements using performance indicators and targets to evaluate the achievement of strategic objectives. The program is as follows:
