Statement of environmental significance

This site contains one of the few remaining, and possibly the oldest of the remnant river red gums in the Port Phillip Area.

Environmental objective to be achieved

To protect the Corroboree Tree from external threats and preserve it in a healthy condition for as long as possible within the constraints imposed by the species life expectancy.

To continue revegetation works on the site using indigenous species of local provenance.

To continue weed control and other horticultural maintenance works.

Permit requirement

A permit is not required to construct a building, to construct or carry out works, or remove destroy or lop any vegetation if it is undertaken in accordance with an approved environmental management plan for this area.
